Main Duties and Responsibilities

<p>Teaching, learning and assessment</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To be a good or an outstanding teacher • To effectively teach children, meeting their many and varied needs • Use a repertoire of strategies to meet children's different learning styles • Have thorough subject knowledge and keep abreast of national and local developments • Provide a highly stimulating classroom environment that supports learning • Plan and teach engaging and effective lessons that motivate, inspire and develop knowledge and excellent learning behaviour • Carry out duties in accordance with the school's aims and policies • Set clear targets for children's learning based on prior attainment • Use formative and summative assessment information to inform all aspects of planning • Display commitment to raising standards and accelerating pupil progress • Work with school leaders to track and improve the progress of individual children • Report to parents on the development, progress and attainment of pupils through written reports and attendance at consultation evenings • Lead, organise and direct support staff to ensure positive learning outcomes for all pupils
<p>Standards and quality assurance</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Support the aims and ethos of the school • Implement agreed school policies and guidelines • Participate in meetings which relate to the school's management, curriculum, administration or organisation • Set a good example in terms of dress, punctuality and attendance • Uphold the school's expectations regarding behaviour and learning • Participate in and contribute to staff training and meetings • Undertake professional development and research • Participate in the performance management system
<p>Additional duties</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Promote the school's vision • Maintain the positive ethos and core values of the school, both inside and outside the school. • Be a role model in all your actions and behaviour • To be aware of and comply with policies and procedures relating to Child Protection and Safeguarding, Health & Safety; and report all concerns to the appropriate person • Undertake other general tasks that the Head Teacher may reasonably ask • Willingness to run a school club that enriches pupils' experiences beyond the classroom
